

STUDY HALL INFORMATION & PERMISSION

Beginning Tuesday, September 2nd, the library will be open for study hall for students in 4th through 8th grades. Study hall is held on Mondays through Thursdays from 3:00 – 4:00 on regular dismissal days and from 2:30 – 4:00 on 2:30 dismissal days. The library will be closed on Friday afternoons and 12:45 dismissal days.

The fire code limits our occupancy to 37 students and must be strictly enforced. Due to this limitation, we may need to assign priority to certain classes on a rotating basis if needed, with Monday and Wednesday having 5th grade priority over 6th, and Tuesday and Thursday having 6th grade priority over 5th.

This is not an extended day care service. For those students attending study hall, it is to be with the understanding that they have homework to do or are busy doing research for projects. With that in mind, students who are not on-task and are distracting to other students will be taken to day care and not allowed to return to study hall for the remainder of the quarter. Since no eating or drinking is allowed in our library, students are asked to eat their snacks outside before signing into study hall.

For safety reasons, students must remain in the library until study hall is over for the afternoon. If you wish to pick up your child before 4:00, you must come to the library personally and sign them out. They will not be dismissed to meet you outside. The remaining students will be escorted to the primary playground at 4:00 to be picked up promptly or go directly to day care or another supervised activity (sports). For those students who are taken to day care, parents will be billed accordingly.
