ALCOHOL POLICY:

The administration, faculty and staff of St. Eugene's Cathedral School are committed to the principle of responsibility and supervision whenever alcoholic beverages are served at school functions. As stated in our philosophy, "... we endeavor to prepare each student for a full life in which decisions are made in a reflective and responsible manner."

The policies for use of alcoholic beverages at any school function are as follows:

- 1. Alcohol will never be served on school premises, including the lunch tables and pavilion area.
- 2. Every function sponsored by the school is reviewed by the school council and the administration to determine if the inclusion of alcoholic beverages is appropriate.
- 3. Service club members may volunteer in school or parish sponsored functions where alcohol is served only with signed parents permission slips.
- 4. No students will be permitted to volunteer or work at an adult only school function.

PROCEDURES FOR USE OF SERVICE CLUB

The service club of St. Eugene's Cathedral School is available to helping at various school and parish sponsored functions. Whenever the service club is involved at a function, the following procedures apply:

- 1. The organizers of the function will appoint an adult who will be responsible for supervising service club members and enforcing the alcohol policy. The supervising adult of the event will have a list of students working the event, and it is the responsibility of the adult to check off the students when they arrive or leave.
- 2. If the function includes alcoholic beverages, a permission slip must be signed by a parent and will be collected by the service club moderator.
- 3. Service club members will never serve, clear or handle alcoholic drinks.
